

IN MEMORY

Over the past few months Bayberry lost three of its residents who were influential in many of the things which we all enjoy today. Residents and friends were saddened with the recent passing of three good neighbors who served the community in its infancy, and later forming what we know today as the BCA.

Sally Drago passed away in August, she and her husband Tony were among the first "pioneers" settling in Bayberry in 1957. They along with other families contributed their time and talents to form what had been called the "Instant Village". Along with her commitment to the BCA Sally was part of the Bayberry Woman's Association and welcoming committee and was the Town of Clay Clerk for over 20 years. Sally was one of several first residents featured in the <u>Liverpool Legends-Bayberry</u> dvd available at the Liverpool Library. **Robert "Bob" Doyle** passed away in September, he and his wife Joan came to Bayberry in 1963. He was very active with the Little League and as a member of American Legion Post 787. Bob was a member of the BCA Board of Directors, Town Affairs chairman and served as President in 1979. He was quite a prominent spokesman for the BCA especially pertaining to the flow and traffic control through the community. We can all thank him for his diligence with the Town keeping Bayberry from being a tractor trailer "cut through". **Marie Eber** passed away in September and was among the first residents to Bayberry with her husband Lou. She became a member of the Board of Directors of the BCA and served on several committees and was involved with many of its activities. Marie served as newsletter editor and was elected 1st Vice President in 1974. She volunteered at Craven Crawford Elementary and Christ The King Parish and in recognition of her outstanding contributions to the community Marie received the <u>Citizen of the Year</u> award in 1978.
