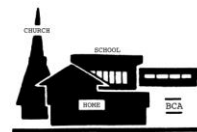
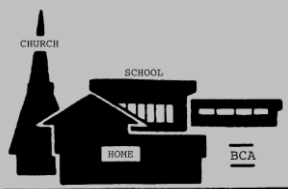

To All Residents of Bayberry,

There has been an alarming increase in the amount of vehicle and home invasions in the last few weeks in our community. Groups of individuals have been rifling through vehicles, garages and escalating to home invasions. On behalf of the residents of our community a letter requesting an increase in police presence has been sent to both County Legislator John Dougherty and Town of Clay Supervisor Damian Ulatowski.

Ultimately the responsibility falls on each one of us to deter these individuals from the invasion of our vehicles and homes by locking the doors, windows, garages of our homes when not there and lock our vehicles at night-much of the unwanted activity is the rifling of vehicles in our driveways. Just as important is watching out for our neighbors, **WE ALL** are the Neighborhood Watch in Bayberry. If you see someone or something unusual going on in your neighborhood, do not hesitate to call 911 and report it, be **PROACTIVE** and not regret not calling. Homes are being invaded during the day through windows, garages and front doors, if you see it **REPORT IT to 911.**

The BCA has no policing powers, however it can give advice and suggestions, the BCA News has posted alerts over the past few months to lock your vehicles...this is your alert to be more vigilant in your neighborhood and to lock your vehicles at night and report to the police anything suspicious and to your area rep or BCA officer. Supervisor Ulatowski has informed the BCA that the Sheriff's Department has added after midnight patrols throughout Bayberry. Thank you Damian.

NEIGHBORHOOD WATCH TIP:

We are a Neighborhood Watch community. Call 911 when you see something suspicious – do not take matters into your own hands. Keep your cars & homes locked. Let's check on your neighbors, if you have not seen them recently, check if they are okay.

TOWN AFFAIRS

No major projects have been presented to the Board at this time. Residents in a couple of other developments in the town are complaining about pot holes and poor street conditions. Supervisor Ulatowski responded that the Town is doing what it can to repair streets, but due to budget constraints, the Highway Department is only able to repair so much at a time. They have a list of priority projects and will visit areas of complaint and get to all as soon as budget allows.

STREET SAFETY:

Everyone needs to be aware of the "rules of the road" and abide by them in order to prevent accidents. Bicycles must ride with the traffic and walkers walk facing the traffic. It is the law. You all need to be especially vigilant as school will be letting out soon. Bayberry Circle, Blackberry and Blueberry are the most heavily traveled roads in Bayberry, so be aware and follow the rules.
