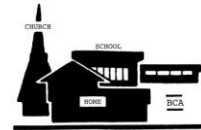


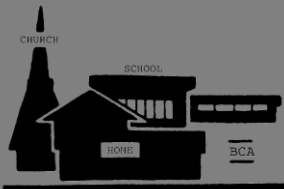

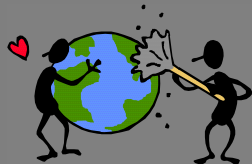

NEIGHBORHOOD WATCH TIP: Let's keep an eye for our neighbors. Spring is here and we all have busy schedules, some are taking out of area vacations. Let your neighbor know when you will be out of town, get a timer and keep a light on in the evenings. Have your newspapers & mail stopped or have someone collect it for you so it doesn't tell strangers nobody is home! With the nice weather arriving please keep your dogs on a leash and pick up their "business" while you walk. We also begin to see door to door sales and services. Please ask any business for their license, business insurance and references prior to hiring. Don't let people you don't know in your home without proper identification or precautions. Some residents are very trusting, be wary of "I'm in the area and I can take care of this work right now!" Don't leave your checkbook or wallet visible to workers. It's better to be safe than sorry.

LOOSE DOGS: We recently had a very unfortunate situation here in Bayberry when a large aggressive dog got out of the owner's home and attacked & killed a very small dog while being walked on a leash by their owner. This tragedy could have been prevented. Please keep your pets under control. Do not allow them to be outside unless on a leash or contained in a fenced yard. **The Town of Clay does have a leash law.** We have walkers, joggers, families biking which many are elderly and children that can not defend themselves from an encounter with a loose dog. It doesn't matter if you, the owner, thinks they won't harm anyone. Due to this recent situation, we have a petition asking the Town of Clay to look into the matter, if you would like to be included in this request, please call or email your name, address and ph#/email. **For the petition call 409-4488 or email the BCA.** The BCA will continue to keep our neighborhoods safe for all its residents even our four legged residents.
